Student practices good Learning, Work, and Safety Skills	90% of weekly grade
<p>Learning Skills</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listens silently to presentations and instructions. • Participates appropriately in class discussions (one at a time, on topic, polite to teachers and students). • Stops talking and making noise when instructor calls for quiet. • Brings a pencil, eraser, and paper to class every day. • Arrives on time for class every day. <p>Work Skills</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Works diligently and silently or very quietly on assignments throughout class time. • Practices art or drawing skills when finished with a project – no idle time in Art class! • Stays in assigned seat except for approved tasks (washing hands, getting supplies, etc). • Does not waste materials or damage tools and facilities. • Cleans up work area at the end of each class. • Puts work, tools, and materials away correctly at the end of each class. <p>Safety Skills</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No horseplay. • No drinks, food, candy, gum, or personal grooming in class • Follows all instructions and all classroom and safety policies <p>Makeup Work</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student makes up work missed during all absences, including illness, travel, sports, ISS, OSS, etc. • Makeup work can be an additional homework assignment, or and 'extra' project from the handouts. • Makeup work must be labeled with the students name and the date of the absence. • Makeup work must be turned in within 2 days of the absence for full credit. 	

Misc. assignments and excellence in classwork and artwork	10% of weekly grade
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student completes extra projects after finishing primary assignments. • Student volunteers to clean up common areas (counters, windows, computers, etc) or to clean up after certain messy projects. • Student helps with classroom support and/or special projects. • Student submits homework projects from the website or outstanding art projects completed at home. • Student shows extraordinary willingness to learn from demonstrations and to participate in discussions. • Student works extra hard on all practice exercises and projects. 	

Tests and Assessment Grades
50% of grade

Tests and Assessments will include:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Written or practical in-class assessments of work skills, learning skills, student progress, art skills and art concepts covered in class • Written or practical take-home assessments of art skills and concepts covered in class • Appraisal of the student's portfolio

The student's Portfolio will be appraised for evidence of significant success on projects and assignments
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student must provide a posterboard folder to use as a portfolio • All classroom art projects and assignments must be completed and included in the portfolio. • All classroom written assignments must be completed accurately and included in the portfolio. • Student's name is signed on all work. • Work will be appraised for neatness, detail, complexity, and creativity. • Work must meet specific instructions for the assignment. • Sketches indicate significant thought and planning for projects. • Portfolio is neat and organized. • Portfolio includes makeup work to substitute for class projects missed during absences. <p>❖ Excellence: Portfolio shows exceptional creativity and attention to detail on projects.</p>
